Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- give an account of and problematise the characteristic traits of the genres modern and contemporary dance, jazz dance and improvisation,
- perform technical dance elements in modern and contemporary dance and jazz dance,
- explore dance improvisation and dance composition,
- perform dance scenically on the basis of the technical and improvisational elements of dance, and
- critically discuss the similarities and differences in modern and contemporary dance and jazz dance.

Content

The course comprises the following components:

- Dance training in modern and contemporary dance and jazz dance
- Dance improvisation and dance composition practice
- Choreographic work in preparation of a scenic performance
- Literature seminars
- Scenic performance
