### Prerequisites

7.5 ECTS credits in dance practice, or documented upper secondary level Dance 1, or equivalent

### Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. portray a character on stage,
2. contribute artistically to a stage performance, and
3. give an account of the different aspects of a stage production and how they interact.

### Content

The course comprises the following components:

- stage performance and preparation
- choreography
- creative activity

- reflection upon each student's own artistic performance and that of others
- rehearsing technique
- character analysis

Instruction is in the form of choreography work, rehearsals, and stage performance.

### **Examination**

Assessment is based on an oral presentation in groups, stage performance, and a written individual hand-in assignment.

Submissions for assessment must clearly indicate individual contributions.

### **Grades**

One of the grades Fail (U), Pass (G), or Distinction (VG) is awarded in the examination of the course.

### **Quality Assurance**

Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation.
