Prerequisites

General admission requirements and upper secondary level English 6 or English level 2, or equivalent

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. define and use basic concepts in literary studies,
2. analyse different types of literature in English at a basic level, and
3. produce structured and coherent analyses of literature in Standard English and use sources correctly.

Content

The course focuses on the analysis of different types and genres of literature in English and introduces basic literary theory and concepts used in literary studies. Students develop

analytical and critical skills through oral and written assignments involving the use of relevant literary concepts.

Examination

Learning outcomes 1 and 2 are assessed based on a written exam and an individual oral presentation.

Learning outcome 2 is also assessed based on an individual written hand-in assignment.

Learning outcome 3 is assessed based on an individual written hand-in assignment.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Quality Assurance

Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation.
