Upon completion of the module, students should be able to:

- 1. explain and use basic syntactic and morphological concepts,,
- 2. describe, explain, and apply common grammatical structures and traits in spoken and written English, with a special focus on issues that might cause difficulties for learners, and 3. use Standard English in writing and identify and give an account of regional and stylistic variations in English.

Content

The module provides a systematic survey of basic grammatical concepts and English syntax and morphology, including practical exercises and comparisons with Swedish. Stylistic and

regional variations are discussed, but the main focus is Standard English.
