Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. give an account of the main features of the historical development 1860-1970 of British children's literature and place such texts in their cultural and intellectual context,
2. analyse and interpret British books for children with the help of basic literary analysis concepts, and
3. produce structured and coherent literary analyses in Standard English.

Content

The course deals with a representative selection of British literature for children from Alice's Adventures in Wonderland to Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. A historical perspective on contemporary children's literature in the fantasy and more realistic genres is provided. The course includes basic literary analysis in practice and some introduction to theories and criticism in the research field of children's literature.

Assessment is based on an oral presentation and a written take-home exam.

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G) or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
