Course Approval

Prerequisites

Spanish 30 ECTS cr at undergraduate level with 22.5 credits completed on enrollment, including the course ESGA20 Written Proficiency 7.5 ECTS cr, or equivalent.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- 1 -give an account of phonological features in Spanish,
- 2 -give an account of the most important morphological structures in Spanish, and
- 3 -identify and describe regional features in Spanish regarding vocabulary, syntax and pronunciation.

Content

The course provides a survey of the phonetical, phonological, and morphological characteristics of Spanish, as well as pronunciation and prosody practice. Regional features of Spanish with an emphasis on pronunciation and syntax are described and discussed.

Examination

Learning outcomes 1 and 2 are assessed on the basis of a written exam.

Learning outcome 3 is assessed on the basis of individual oral presentations in class.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
