Course Approval

Prerequisites

General admission requirements plus upper secondary level English 6 or B, or equivalent

Learning Outcomes

The aim of the course is to introduce the knowledge area of child development and learning and for students to develop knowledge, values, and approaches related to interaction with children in different situations and environments.

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to

1. give an account of a few basic theoretical perspectives on child development,
2. give an account of different teaching approaches related to early childhood development and learning,
3. explain basic principles for children's rights in terms of the UN Convention on the Rights of a Child, and

4. give an account of diversity and variation in relation to child development and learning.

Content

The course covers the following:

- Introduction to theories of child development and learning.
- Different teaching approaches in pre-school.
- Basic principles related to children's rights.
- Diversity and variation in an inclusive pre-school.

Examination

Learning outcome 1: Assessment is based on an individual written take-home exam.

Learning outcome 2: Assessment is based on an oral and written group report.

Learning outcomes 3 and 4: Assessment is based on a written group report.
