Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, the students should be able to:

- give a general account of theories on the construction of gender in organisations and leadership,
- problematise and critically discuss empirical phenomena from a gender-based perspective,
- evaluate and discuss aspects of gender in organisations and leadership.

The course gives an introduction to how leadership, leadership theory, and the development and theories of organisational studies affect the construction of social gender in the working life.
