Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- give an account of the basic theoretical perspectives of cultural encounters,
- give an account of theories and concepts regarding cultural identities from an intercultural studies perspective,
- use intercultural interpretation models to describe the forming of social and cultural identities, and
- analyse how cultural and religious value patterns impact on people's everyday lives.

Content

The course is an introduction to intercultural studies of cultural encounters and identity creation. An overview of different aspects of cultural meetings is provided along with links between different cultural contexts and cultural identities in contemporary society. Students give a seminar presentation of a cultural encounter scenario.
