Swedish, with some components in English

Admission to the SGWOM Web and Multimedia programme or the SGITD IT-design programme

IKA (Information Systems)

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- produce HTML-documents (Hypertext Markup Language) containing text, images, forms, sound and video,
- produce CSS-documents (Cascading Style Sheets) for the layout of HTML-documents,
- produce CSS-documents for the formatting of HTML-documents, and
- publish HTML- and CSS-documents with the help of a webserver.

Content and Form of Instruction

The course deals with how to structure a webpage with HTML and how to present the content of the HTML page with CSS regarding formatting and layout, and how to publish HTML and CSS documents with the help of webserver.

Examination

Assessment is based on hand-in assignments and a written exam.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
