- present the project orally and in writing to cultural sector commissioner, and
- design, and present to and discuss a written project report with the course conveners.

Content

Students plan, carry out, and evaluate a project commissioned by or in cooperation with cultural sector actors. The results of the projects are presented to the external client and the course conveners at the end of the course.

Examination

Assessment is based on a oral and written report to the external client according to their instructions, and an individual written report presented and discussed in a mandatory seminar.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
