Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- give an account of the basic theories of project planning and project management,
- give an account of methods for planning and evaluating a cultural project,
- present a plan for a cultural project, and
- make an application for project funding.

Content

The course provides an introduction to the theory and methods of planning, conducting and evaluating a cultural project. Course components include project planning, project management, organisation, group dynamics, financing and evaluation. Students plan and present the project plans for a fictive cultural project (case).

Assessment is based on hand-in assignments, individually and in groups, which are presented and discussed in mandatory seminars.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
