Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the module, students should be able to:

- give an account of methods and theoretical frames of relevance to research on cultural policy,

- apply cultural studies methods and theories to the analysis of the conditions, fields of activities and forms of expression of the cultural sector as reflected in current cultural policy.

Content and Form of Instruction

The module introduces cultural studies methodological and theoretical frame for analysing the cultural sector, its conditions, field of activities and forms of expressions in relation to current cultural policy.
