Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. give an account of and apply different narration techniques in prose and poetry at an advanced level,
2. engage in in-depth constructive peer review of texts written by others,
3. use language creatively and consciously in an independently produced work of fiction.

Content

The course offers specialisation in Creative Writing and focuses on the students' own writing, combined

with peer review and oral and written assignments based on the theory and practice of fiction-writing. The course includes written assignments, peer review, lectures, seminars, and literature study.

Learning objective 1 is assessed on the basis of individual written hand-in assignments.

Learning objective 2 is assessed on the basis of individual peer review.

Learning objective 3 is assessed on the basis of an independently produced fictional text processed throughout the course.

Grades

One of the grades Fail (F) or Pass (G) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Quality Assurance

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation.
