Learning Outcomes

The aim of the course is to consolidate and develop the mathematical skills acquired at upper secondary school C level as well as certain parts of the D level.

Upon completion of the course, the student should be able to:

- perform algebraic calculations in a reliable way
- perform polynomial long division
- solve power equations, exponential equations and logarithmic equations
- solve equations and inequalities containing absolute values
- use the unit circle to define trigonometric concepts and prove trigonometric relations, use formulas to transpose trigonometric expressions, solve trigonometric equations and draw graphs for trigonometric functions
- compute sides and angles in triangles

Content and Form of Instruction

Review of algebraic techniques, numerical and algebraic computations, algebraic fractions, equations, inequalities, absolute values, roots, powers, logarithms, trigonometry, and the equation for a straight line.

Examination is in the form of hand-in assignments.

Grades

One of the grades U (Fail) or G (Pass) is awarded in the examination of the course.
