Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- plan, conduct and evaluate in a team varied and flexible instrument classes with second-year instrument learners,
- apply more indepth methods and models for playful learning for this group, and
- identify and apply indepth knowledge of group dynamic processes in the early learner groups.

Content and Form of Instruction

The course comprises the following components:

- Instrumental methodology
- Instrumental rhythmic
- Playful learning with pulse, rhythm, movement, singing, playing by ear and simple music reading
- Group dynamics
- Practical application of instrument teaching.

Assessment is based on individual and group performance, oral group examination and individual written exam.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
