- interpret music in terms of the appropriate tone and intonation aspects associated with the ensemble form, and the idioms of repertoire and genre.

#### Content

The course comprises the following components:

- Ensemble playing

- Rehearsing
- Musical interpretation
- Repertoire knowledge
- Style awareness
- Tone and intonation

**Examination**

Assessment is based on a musical group performance.
