Learning Outcomes

- demonstrate skills in musical performance in an ensemble,
- play in an ensemble demonstrating understanding of the role of each musician in the ensemble, and
- demonstrate ability to create music in interplay with others with the appropriate idiom of the ensemble form, repertoire and genre.

Content

The course comprises the following components:

- Ensemble playing

- Rehearsing
- Musical interpretation
- Repertoire knowledge
- Style awareness
- Musical expression

Examination

Assessment is based on a musical group performance.

The number of examination opportunities is limited to five.
