#### Course Approval

#### Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- identify their own role and function in the ensemble and those of other members in the type of ensemble concerned,
- problematise methods to solve musical problems in the ensemble, and
- demonstrate communicative skills in their performance to an audience.

#### Content

The course comprises the following components:

- Ensemble playing
- Rehearsing
- Musical interpretation
- Repertoire knowledge
- Style awareness
- Musical communication

**Examination**

Learning outcomes are assessed in groups, both orally and on the basis of musical group performance.

The number of examination opportunities is limited to five.
