Major Field of Study

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- independently rehearse and prepare ensemble parts for a chosen project,
- interact with and be a musical model to the ensemble members, and
- perform ensemble music publicly with the appropriate sense of style, sound, intonation, and expression.

Content and Form of Instruction

The course centres on individual study and preparation of ensemble parts, ensemble rehearsal, and at least one public artistic presentation of the course repertoire.

Instruction is in the form of a short-period project.

Examination

Assessment is based on a musical performance.

The number of examination opportunities is limited to five.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Quality Assurance

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course assessment is based on student views and experiences as reported in written course evaluations and/or group discussions. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of the measures to be taken.

Course Certificate

A course certificate will be provided upon request.

Students who enrolled before 1 July 2007 will complete their studies in accordance with the requirements of the earlier admission. Upon completion students may request degree and course certificates to be issued under the current ordinance if they meet its requirements.
