#### Course Approval

The syllabus was approved by the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences 2018-02-14, and is valid from the Autumn semester 2018 at Karlstad University.

#### Prerequisites

60 ECTS credits completed for a music programme involving instrument/vocal and ensemble studies

#### Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to

1. study their own parts in an ensemble repertoire before ensemble rehearsals,
2. apply rehearsal techniques for ensembles when rehearsing and performing in an ensemble,
3. musically perform a repertoire on the basis of a conception of form, style and performance praxis,
4. demonstrate musical ability in playing with others in an ensemble, and
5. perform and communicate an ensemble repertoire to an audience.

#### Content

Students create music together in an ensemble, formed on the basis of the students' instruments and genre specialisation. The repertoire varies with the ensembles.

Instruction is in the form of individual and ensemble rehearsals.

#### Examination

Assessment is individual and based on ensemble performances and oral presentations.

**Grades**

One of the grades Pass (G) or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course (Dnr C2017/889).

**Quality Assurance**

Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation.
