MIGAS3 String Orchestra III, 7.5 ECTS cr, or equivalent

Major Field of Study

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- compile the standard repertoire of the string orchestra,
- notate bowing for all the orchestra parts before rehearsals,
- instruct on bow-stroke, sound, intonation, and performance praxis of importance to the artistic expression of the string orchestra,
- interact with the conductor and other musicians in the orchestra,
- act according to praxis during stage performance

Content and Form of Instruction

The course comprises the following components:

- playing in a string orchestra
- musical communication
- knowledge of style and epoch
- scenic presence

Instruction is mainly in groups. Section and orchestra rehearsals require students to have studied their parts properly.

Examination

Assessment is based on musical performance in groups and on an individual written assignment.

The number of examinations are limited to five.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Quality Assurance

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course assessment is based on student views and experiences as reported in written course evaluations and/or group discussions. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of the measures to be taken.

Course Certificate

A course certificate will be provided upon request.

Additional Information

Students who enrolled before 1 July 2007 will complete their studies in accordance with the requirements of the earlier admission. Upon completion students may request degree and course certificates to be issued under the current ordinance if they meet its requirements.
