General admission requirements plus satisfactory entry test to a higher education music programme, or equivalent.

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- play or sing at a basic level,
- master the course repertoire and place it in a cultural and music historical context,
- perform music in accordance with standard praxis.

Content

Instruction is in the form of instrument playing or vocal classes. Instruction includes musical performance and communicative awareness and repertoire study as specified in the reading list.

Examination

Assessment is based on musical performance and a written individual assignment.

The number of examination opportunities is limited to five.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G) or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Quality Assurance

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of any measures to be taken.

A course certificate will be provided upon request.

Additional information

Students who enrolled before 1 July 2007 will complete their studies in accordance with the requirements of the earlier admission.

Upon completion students may request degree and course certificates to be issued under the current ordinance if they meet its requirements.
