Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- play or sing at a basic level,
- master the course repertoire from a sound and intonation perspective and place it in a cultural and music historical context,
- perform music with vocal sound and intonation in accordance with standard praxis.

Content and Form of Instruction

Instruction is in the form of instrument playing or vocal classes, individually or in groups. Instruction includes musical performance and communicative awareness as well as repertoire study.

Examination

Assessment is based on musical performance and an oral individual presentation.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G) or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

## Quality Assurance

Course assessment is based on student views and experiences as reported in written course evaluations and/or group discussions. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of the measures to be taken.
