Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- give a personal rendition of music of a chosen style or genre,
- demonstrate communicative skills in their performance,
- give an account of and apply suitable warming-up exercises and good ergonomic posture for their instrument or singing, and
- demonstrate basic knowledge of relevant repertoire for the genre and instrument/voice and use the knowledge in a musical context.

Content and Form of Instruction

The course comprises the following components:

- Instrumental or voice studies
- Warming-up and ergonomic exercises
- Musical rendition and communication
- Scenic presence

Assessment is based on individual performance and oral presentation.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
