- independently seek information about a piece of music and give an account of its cultural context, and
- present and perform a music piece to an audience.

Content

The course comprises the following components:

- instrumental or vocal practice individually and in a small group
- interpretation
- music history overview
- artistic expression
- instrumental skills
- repertoire knowledge
- music listening
