Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- prepare and perform music pieces in different musical styles with artistic expression,
- demonstrate instrumental skills in relation to the interpreted musical material,
- give an account of the stylistic content of different musical works, and
- independently analyse the musical form and structure of different works.

Content

Instrumental or vocal practice individually or in a small group
Interpretation
Analysis of form, style, and structure
Music history overview
Artistic expression
Instrumental skills
Repertoire knowledge
Music listening

Examination

Assessment is individual and based on oral presentation and musical performance.
