Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- prepare and perform an advanced piece of music in a chosen musical style with artistic expression,
- demonstrate instrumental skills in relation to the interpreted musical material, and
- present and perform a music piece to an audience on the basis of a chosen perspective.

Content

The course includes the following components:

Instrumental or vocal practice individually or in a small group

Interpretation

Music history overview, including different perspectives
Analysis of form and structure
Artistic expression
Instrumental skills
Repertoire knowledge
Music listening

Examination

Assessment is individual and based on oral presentation and musical performance without sheet music.
