### Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. notate and with voice and instrument reproduce tonal, modal, and free tonal melodies, extended harmonies and advanced rhythms,
2. describe and reproduce more advanced harmonic functions in major and minor tonal music,
3. orchestrate the most common instrument families at a basic level, and
4. compose a modal piece of music.

### Content

The course offers students the opportunity to practise the notation and reproduction of rhythms,

melodies, and chords. In relation to orchestration, the basic principles of writing music for the most common instrument families are studied, as well as the instruments themselves.

**Examination**

Assessment of learning outcome 1 is based on individual written and oral presentations, as well as singing and playing instruments.

Assessment of learning outcomes 2-4 is based on individual written hand-in assignments.

**Grades**

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
