Course Approval

The syllabus was approved by the Board of Teacher Education 2025-02-12, and is valid from the Autumn semester 2025 at Karlstad University.

Prerequisites

Completed Music and Music Teaching 6, 7.5 ECTS credits, Teachers' pedagogical approach 2 - Music teachers, 7.5 ECTS credits, and Teacher Training Practice 2 - Music Education, 7.5 ECTS credits, plus Instrument and Ensemble 4, 15 ECTS credits, or Classroom Music Teaching 4, 15 ECTS credits, or Music Theory and Composition 4, 15 ECTS credits, or Music and Sound Production 4, 15 ECTS credits, or equivalent

Learning Outcomes

The aim of the course is for students to develop the ability to interpret and create music independently, from both artistic and educational perspectives, as well as contribute to the musical and artistic learning of others.

Module 1: Instrument, 5.5 ECTS cr.

Upon completion of this module, students should be able to:

1. interpret selected repertoire musically and demonstrate the ability to engage in musical

communication,

- 2- demonstrate strong musical expression in interaction with others, and
3. develop a preliminary plan for an artistic project.

Module 2: Music education, 2 ECTS cr.

Upon completion of this module, students should be able to:

1. in a well-developed and insightful manner, give an account of methodological aspects of teaching their main instrument on an intermediate and/or advanced level based on the chosen approach for the instrument, and
2. conduct teaching on the main instrument in the form of supervised lessons or lesson segments in a well-developed and insightful manner, and reflect upon their own teaching from an educational perspective.

Content

The course comprises two modules. The course content prepares students for school-based placements within the subject area.

Module 1: Instrument, 5.5 ECTS cr.

- playing the main instrument through both individual instrumental lessons and ensemble playing
- planning an artistic project
- introduction to stage communication

Module 2: Music education, 2 ECTS cr.

- instrumental methodology seminars with selected themes
- in-depth methodological aspects based on the chosen approach for the main instrument
- supervised teaching practice on the main instrument within compulsory or elective school activities
- reflections on the completed supervised teaching practice

Examination

Module 1

Learning outcomes 1 and 2 are assessed based on practical musical performance, completed individually and in groups.

Learning outcome 3 is assessed based on an individual written assignment.

Module 2

Learning outcomes 1 and 2 are assessed based on individual and group oral presentations, individual written hand-in assignments, and teaching practice.

Submissions for assessment must clearly indicate individual contributions.

The number of assessment opportunities is limited to five.

If students have a decision from Karlstad University entitling them to Targeted Study Support due to a documented disability, the examiner has the right to give such students an adapted examination or to examine them in a different manner.

Grades

One of the grades Pass (G) or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course (RB 129/22 Dnr C2022/895).

Quality Assurance

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of any measures to be taken.
