Major Field of Study

Economics

Aims

The aim of the course is that the students should acquire basic knowledge and understanding of econometrics.

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- -construct models for prognostication,
- -understand and use the least squares method for estimating linear regression models,
- -analyse regression models with dummy variables, and
- -evaluate the adapted models with respect to heteroskedacity, multi-collinearity, and auto-correlation.

Course Content

The course will cover the following topics:

- -models for linear regression and model specification,
- -multi-collinearity, heteroskedacity, and auto-correlation, and
- -introduction to time-serial analysis.

Examination is in the form of written assignments and a final written exam.

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.
