15 ECTS credits completed in GIS (Geographical Information Systems), Geographical Information Technology, or equivalent

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

- create and model geographical data processes in FME (feature manipulation engine) software,
- apply tools for data validation in a geographic database,
- create and evaluate workflows for geographic data manipulation,
- independently identify, formulate, and handle issues and analyse and evaluate different technical solutions in accordance with specifications, and
- complete a written account of problems and suggested solutions to geodata problems in

FME

Content

The course includes geographic data handling exercises and hands-on FME tasks. Course components include data format problems, data in different coordinate systems, and topology requirements for geographic objects. The course concludes with a project.

Examination

Assessment is based on individual written hand-in assignments and a project presented orally and in writing. In one of the examination sessions, students are required to prove their identity.

If students have a decision from Karlstad University entitling them to Targeted Study Support due to a documented disability, the examiner has the right to give such students an adapted examination or to examine them in a different manner.

Grades

One of the grades 5 (Pass with Distinction), 4 (Pass with some Distinction), 3 (Pass), or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation.
