### Course Approval

### Prerequisites

Supervision in Clinical Studies I, 7.5 ECTS credits, and upper secondary level Swedish 3 or Swedish as a second language 3, and English 6, or equivalent

### Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. analyse and argue about different theories and models of supervision,
2. analyse and reflect upon the function of the supervisor in different learning situations,
3. describe and reflect upon the significance of supervision for professional development,
4. critically review and synthesize research in the field of supervision, and
5. give an account of and apply quality assurance and development of supervision in clinical practice.

**Content**

**Examination**

Assessment is individual and based on a take-home exam discussed in a seminar.

Supplementary examination is permitted if 1) material for the assessment of a learning outcome is lacking, 2) if the result is close to the requirements for a Pass grade. Additional material must be submitted within six days of notification.

If students have a decision from Karlstad University entitling them to Targeted Study Support due to a documented disability, the examiner has the right to give such students an adapted examination or to examine them in a different manner.

**Grades**

One of the grades Fail (U), Pass (G), or Distinction (VG) is awarded in the examination of the course.

**Quality Assurance**

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and documentation. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of any measures to be taken.
