Course Approval

The syllabus was approved by the Faculty of Health, Science and Technology 2019-03-13, and is valid from the Autumn semester 2019 at Karlstad University.

Prerequisites

Basic Nursing and the Nursing Profession, 30 ECTS credits, Basic Clinical Nursing, 30 ECTS credits, Nursing in Relation to Symptoms and Signs of Illness, 37.5 ECTS credits, and registration on Nursing in Emergency Situations, 7.5 ECTS credits, with at least 3.5 ECTS credits completed, Research Methods in Nursing, 7.5 ECTS credits, with at least 3.5 ECTS credits completed, and Nursing in Longterm Illness and Multimorbidity, 30 ECTS credits, or equivalent

Learning Outcomes

Knowledge and understanding

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

1. identify and formulate problem areas and research issues in the field of nursing and choose a method

Competence and skills

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

2. conduct literature searches and use adequate search strategies required for the chosen research project
3. carry out data collection and data analysis and critically discuss the results and method
4. apply research ethical principles appropriate to the research (degree project)
5. complete a written degree project in the subject area
6. orally present and defend their project within given time limits and critically review written works in the field

Judgement and approach

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to:

7. assess the importance of their own work (degree project) in relation to nursing and to relevant social and ethical aspects.

Content

Instruction is in the form of literature studies, lectures, supervision, and seminars. The degree project is normally carried out in the form of a literature study by two students working together, but other formats may be used. Students have the opportunity to write in English but the student is responsible for language editing.

The course comprises the following components:

- completing a degree project
- conducting database searches
- collecting, processing, and analysing data
- reflecting on research ethics
- presenting a project in writing (degree project)
- defending and peer reviewing
- participating in seminars

Examination

Assessment is based on an independent degree project discussed in a seminar and the student's performance as a writer and a peer reviewer, and on contributions made at further seminars.

Supplementary revisions may be allowed if submitted within 15 workdays of notification.

Supervision is provided for the duration of the course. Reregistered students are offered additional supervision for a limited period after the course, at the most six months.

If students have a decision from Karlstad University entitling them to special pedagogical support due to a documented disability, the examiner has the right to give such students an adapted examination or to examine them in a different manner.

Grades

One of the grades Distinction (VG), Pass (G) or Fail (U) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Quality Assurance

Follow-up relating to learning conditions and goal-fulfilment takes place both during and upon completion of the course in order to ensure continuous improvement. Course evaluation is partly based on student views and experiences obtained in accordance with current regulations and partly on other data and

documentation. Students will be informed of the result of the evaluation and of any measures to be taken.

The courses OMGC21 or OMG207 cannot be included in the same degree programme as the course OMG007.
