### **Major Field of Study**

Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of the course, students should be able to demonstrate basic knowledge of the history, theory and method of rhetoric, and basic skills in using the appropriate form of oral communication with regard to different purposes and situations.

Content and Form of Instruction

The course includes:

- Theoretical rhetoric and practical exercises
- Planning a speech by collecting material, organising, formulating, memorizing and practising it

- Improvisation exercises - the importance of situation and function of speech, and how to overcome speech anxiety

- Examples of different types of oral communication

- Theories of speech and writing differences

Instruction is in the form of lectures, discussions, seminars, supervision and groupwork. Individual assignments are given.

Examination

Examination is in the form a written and oral tests at the end of the course. Examination is based on the student's participation in discussions and groupwork and on individual oral and written assignments.

Grades

One of the grades Fail (F), Pass (G) or Distinction (VG) is awarded in the examination of the course.

Course assessment is based on student views and experiences as reported in written course evaluations and/or group discussions.
