While you are a student at Karlstad University, you will use your KauID to access “My Page”, itslearning and the campus wireless network. “My Page” is where your results are registered, where you register for courses, sign up for exams, create a transcript of records, make an early withdrawal from a course, view old exam papers, change your address etc.

You must register for the course that you have been admitted to via “My Page” at the Student Portal <http://www.kau.se/en/current-students>. Please read the information on web registration available at <http://www.kau.se/en/current-students/new-students>. For the course Aspects of Sweden, web registration will be open from 18 – 29 august.

Please note that you must register on your course no later than the day the course starts, otherwise you will lose your place on the course in question.

*Itslearning* is used as the Internet platform for course information and hand-in assignments. The platform will be opened around one week before the start of the course. As soon as you have accessed your KauID, you can log in to itslearning, [www.its.kau.se](http://www.its.kau.se). Choose “Log in with KauID and enter your log-in details and view your course registrations. Contact the course administrator if any course you have been admitted to is missing.
