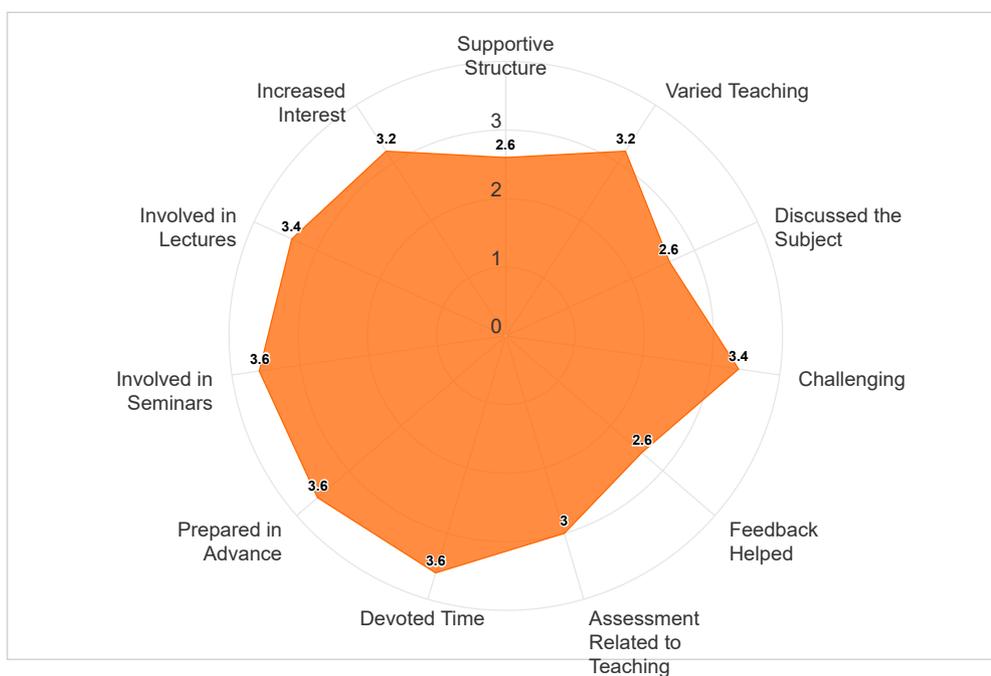

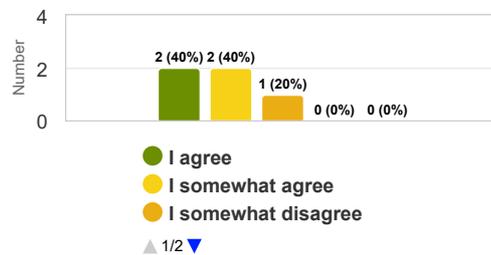

Results of learning

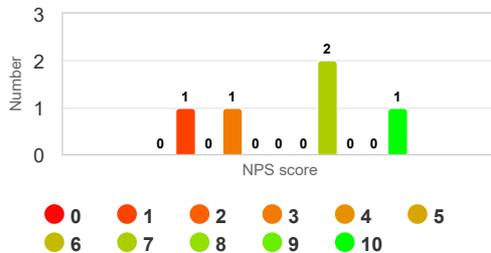
All in all, the course was valuable for me.

Net Promoter Score (NPS) = -20

The Net Promoter Score (NPS) is a metric that measures student experience and predicts the effectiveness of a course. It calculates an NPS score based on a key question using a 0-10 scale, asking how likely students would recommend the course to others. Respondents are grouped into Promoters, Passives, or Detractors based on their score, and the NPS is calculated by subtracting the percentage of Detractors from the percentage of Promoters. The NPS is a core metric for course evaluation programs and is trusted by educational institutions to engage their students and improve their learning experience performance.

Course supervisor's comments

Studenterna är överlag nöjda med kursen men samtidigt finns det några studenter som visar mindre nöjdhet. Enkätsvaren och fritextsvaren ger en samlad bild av hur kursen har upplevts.

Positiva aspekter:

Samarbete i undervisning, inspirerande föreläsare, interaktivitet, relevant innehåll

Konstruktiv kritik:

Studenterna önskar mer specialpedagogik, de teoretiska perspektiven och det vetenskapliga skrivandet är utmanande, några studenter upplever det utmanande att läsa flera områden parallellt. Någon student uttrycker att vissa uppgiftsinstruktioner är allt för omfattande.

Kursledarnas reflektioner:

Med hänsyn tagen till den konstruktiva kritiken, är vår reflektion att relevansen för innehållet i vissa fall behöver tydliggöras. Det stöd som erbjuds i det vetenskapliga skrivandet är fortsatt viktigt. Kursen är uppdelad på många yrkesämnesdidaktiska grupper med många olika didaktiker, vilket begränsar våra möjligheter att dra några generella slutsatser.
