<p>Strengths of the course according to the students</p> <p>Q1: What are your main impressions from this course? “- My general impression about the course is very positive. Through realizing an own research proejct, reading the course literature and especially through very personal tutoring I gained a lot knowledge which will be very helpfully for future research projects, e.g. my master thesis.” ”- Good knowledge about scientific methods and how to conduct a research project.”</p> <p>Q2: What individual knowledge acquired/lessons learned have you gained from participating in this course? ”- I gained a lot of skills in conducting research projects, applying different quantitative & qualitative research methods and how to plan/organize a research project.” ”- Knowledge about the various different method considerations during a scientific research project.”</p> <p>Q3: What has been the best with participating in this course? “- The best was the low number of participants through which it was possible to get individual support by the tutor.” ”- The "own" research project.”</p> <p>Q8: Do you want to recommend this course to others? Why not? ”- I would strongly recommend this course to others because conducting an own research project with additional personal tutoring is a unique possibility to enhance your skills in conducting research projects while getting helpfully advices by your tutor. <p>Weaknesses of the course according to the students</p> <p>"- According to my opinion, the course required a much higher workload than justified by the given 7,5 credits. Especially the own research project required a lot of time. But as I chose the scope of my topic, this is also up to me. But for the future, my improvement proposal would be to pay more attention to the students' topic selection and support them to figure out an appropriate scope for the research project which is realizable in scheduled time."</p> <p>"- The amount of work to carry out. For a 7,5 point course it is too much, in my opinion. Either a qualitative or quantitative study would be more realistic to complete during the course."</p>
