Weaknesses of the course according to the students

"- According to my opinion, the course required a much higher workload than justified by the given 7,5 credits. Especially the own research project required a lot of time. But as I chose the scope of my topic, this is also up to me. But for the future, my improvement proposal would be to pay more attention to the students' topic selection and support them to figure out an appropiate scope for the research project which is realizable in scheduled time."

"- The amount of work to carry out. For a 7,5 point course it is too much, in my opinion. Either a qualitative or quantitative study would be more realistic to complete during the course."
