





The Campus course Service Management and IT: e-Business (ISGC07), Autumn 21, had 18 course participants - among which 3 were exchange students (2 from Germany & 1 from Vietnam). The course was therefore delivered entirely in English.

During the 2016-2018 courses, Odd Fredriksson co-developed and co-tutored the entrepreneurially oriented sharp case Project Work in the course with Martin Hamilton, Drivhuset. There was a Karlstad University article published about this innovative Project Work part of the course after it had been run for the third consecutive third-year (November 26, 2018):

Since 2019, Odd Fredriksson has been the sole tutor of all Project Work student teams in this course.

The teacher offered the usual (Survey&Report) Course Development survey about the course (with 18 questions), which collects a broader scope of perceptions from the course participants than the ÖKA survey which provides valuable feedback from the course participants in order to being able to develop the course. This Course Development survey include the Student Union?s questions about perceived Quality and perceived Work load.

18 out of 18 course participants answered this survey (i.e. a response rate of 100%). According to the course development survey report, the average perceived QUALITY of the whole course (100% response rate) was 4.1 (was 3.3 in 2020; 3.7 in 2019; 3.5 in 2018; 4.0 in 2017; 3.9 in 2016). 17 out of 18 course participants (94%) perceive that the overall course quality had been Very high or High (for the 2020 course this share was 36%).

According to the survey report the average perceived WORK LOAD during the course was 4.0 (was 3.9 in 2020; 3.5 in 2019; 4.3 in 2018 and 2017; 3.7 in 2016).

Noone (0) of the 18 course participants spent more than full-time on the course (41 hours or more), which gives a perspective on that 4 of them (22%) perceived that the work load was very high.

Selection of answers on four of the TEACHER'S individual written COURSE DEVELOPMENT SURVEY questions:

Q1, Individual Written: What are your MAIN IMPRESSIONS from this course?

The uprising of Service Management in forms like the Service-Dominant Logic for example was a new thing that now that I was thinking about it a lot is really true. Another aspect that I really kept in mind was the Paper about Lean Startups and the whole topic about User/Customer involvement gave very interesting insights on the development of a sustainable product.

SDL as a concept as a very important thing to keep in mind for the future: That there is a lot about the aspects to think about for the development of IT concepts and there will be a lot more to learn about it in the future.

That even though we have come very far on how the internet impacts the world and our society, the development will increase and that makes it very relevant to stay active and always strive for improvement when it comes to e-Business.

The major individual knowledge that I have taken from this course is a better understanding of entrepreneurial approaches and methods to conduct important information. And to get a better understanding of the perceived problems that I will encounter in the future.

I have learned a lot about service marketing, e-Business and Enterprise Systems. I also developed innovative and entrepreneurial thinking while participating in the project and seminars.

To try to start with the group project as soon as possible and study even more for the exam. I have of course gotten a lot of knowledge from the lessons as well, possibly more than in any other course.

Q10, Individual Written: How do you perceive the SHARP CASE-based PROJECT WORK in teams?

The best with the project work is that you actually analyze a real case organisation and a REAL problem. I mean otherwise in other courses we only had fictive problems and it is very fun to be involved in a real problem that actually exists. I actually don?t know how to improve it since I think the tutor lessons gave us a lot of good information and it was very clear what we should do and not should do. The best with the project work was to integrate with other students such as exchange students but also the people in the class since we haven?t met for such a long time.

My opinion is that I learned in a good way by work in groups instead of individual learning methods.

I think the project work has been good and educational. What I find a little difficult with this work is to get access to a company and it can take a long time, which can affect the time of the whole work.

Good to have focus on the report after the examination, good layout with clear instructions and tutoring.

I believe that the project work has been by far the most rewarding part of the course work, especially with ample opportunities to well-timed tutoring and motivated team mates. However, the project work tutoring could easily be held via a distance medium, since several of the course participants have some travel distance to get to the physical location. The only improvement to the project work that I can think of would be, for the groups that had difficulties finding a case organization, to be able to have a select few in stock so that the remainder of the project does not get so stressful, making the end result better for all parties involved. I also think it is very good that the teams are randomized, opening up the opportunity to learn with new people, something that probably would not happen if teams were chosen.

The best with the project work I would say was the presentation and opposition, fun and interesting experience. I believe that the project work process could be improved by regulating deadlines of the different parts of the report. So that you can not leave everything until last.

I think the SPIN interviews and the presentations were the best. Learning from others is the best way for me to stimulate my learning. Share knowledge to create new knowledge.

I really enjoyed the project work with the team. Supporting each other and discussing different aspects of the project was very inspiring and often the others had perspectives on problems that I simply did not have in mind.

I think that the case as a whole was very good learning. I do think that the time was a bit less than needed, since we needed to prepare for the exam.

I have the best team I could ask for. Perhaps that makes our Project work more exciting and interesting. I also like the fact that we had to find a case firm ourselves and analyse their problems instead of having given the general case. It allows us to be more critical and initiative.

I perceived it as good and I think to present the solution for the company was the best part and that they were able to listen to the seminar. It was a very slow start to the group project and maybe a bit unclear at first what we were supposed to do which may have made certain parts of the group work a bit stressful. But it worked out in the end anyways. It was also very hard to find a case organisation that wanted to cooperate and had some sort of problem they wanted to fix.

The meetings with the team were the best. I liked to work within a team, where every participant was engaging. It showed me how much I like to work in teams.

Getting to dive deeper within an organisation that allowed us. Overall the project work was good, but if we were given more time to prepare for the presentation it would have been better.

It was a little bit unclear of what we were supposed to do in the beginning, so it took some unnecessary time to get the project rolling. But I really did love my group and was satisfied, because we shared similar ambitions and study motivation. So it became easier to approach the project work. One suggestion would be like to give better examples of previous works from previous participants.

I think the project work was a good practice for future endeavours.
